Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been really lovely to have all the children back in school for the last 2 weeks after our Easter break. Please can we remind you to continue to follow the same guidelines that we have been working to throughout this year.

Please remember that on coming onto the school site face masks should be worn unless you are medically exempt. We would also ask that where possible you avoid arriving early, as this can cause more congestion in and around the school site.

We continue to follow the guidance that if anyone in your household develops COVID symptoms:

- New and persistent cough
- Raised temperature
- Loss of sense of smell or taste

Everyone in the household should self-isolate and the person who is symptomatic should get a PCR test.

If you have any concerns about any additional symptoms and feel that you may have been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID in the previous 10 days, you should also get a PCR test.

Thank you for working with us to keep everyone in school safe and to keep our class bubbles open.
